It is found from Norway and Sweden to the Iberian Peninsula, Italy and Greece and from Great Britain to the Baltic States, Romania and Bulgaria. It is also found in southern Russia. The wingspan is 12-18 mm. Adults are on wing in June and July. The larvae feed within seedpods of Anthyllis vulneraria. They live within a movable case. A moth is an insect closely related to the butterfly, both being of the order Lepidoptera. Moths form the majority of this order; there are thought to be 150,000 to 250,000 different species of moth (about ten times the number of species of butterfly), with thousands of species yet to be described.
